Suspension of Nonessential Border Crossings



Mexico - United States

- Starting at 12:01 a.m. on Saturday, March 21, and for a period of 30 days, border crossings between the two countries are limited to essential travel only.
- Nonessential travel to the United States for tourism, recreational or cultural purposes will not be permitted.
- Travel for workers and students who cross the border daily will not be restricted.
- Travel for people involved in cross-border commerce, such as truck drivers, will not be restricted.
- Mexican and United States citizens may freely return to their respective countries, and travel for medical purposes will be allowed in both directions.
- People with emergencies or public health issues may cross the border normally.
- These restrictions do not apply to air or sea travel. However, the recommendation is only to travel if absolutely necessary.
