Idaho - Mexico Trade Highlights

1. Mexico is Idaho's 8th largest export destination for 2011.
2. Idaho's trade with Mexico grew 13.2% from 2010 to almost \$210 million in 2011.
3. Idaho's exports of Cereals increased nearly 92% from 2010 for a total of \$30.6 million.
4. Food and Agriculture products accounted for almost 61.2% of Idaho's exports, making Mexico the 2nd largest agricultural export market for Idaho.
