



FAMILY UNITY

- **A Familiar Unity - Temporary or Permanent Resident Visa is the first step if you want to live in Mexico with a Mexican citizen, Temporary or Permanent Resident card holder or Temporary or Permanent visa holder, who must be physically present at the time of the interview.**
- **The visa approval can take up to 10 business days, is valid for six months and includes one entry. Once the applicant arrives in Mexico, it is mandatory to present the Resident Visa at the INM (National Institute of Migration) within the first 30 calendar days of arrival, in order to request a Temporary Resident Card.**

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

1. Visa application.
2. Valid passport and copy of the main page.
3. One color picture, passport size, front view, with no eyeglasses and white background.
4. Document that proves that the applicant is a foreign legal resident of the USA (I-797, I-20 advance parole, etc.). This applies for non-US citizens.
5. Consular fee: \$51 USD. Cash or credit payment (Visa or MasterCard). Non Refundable if not approved.
6. Proof of economic solvency: bank statements or steady income for the last 12 months, with a monthly average of \$1,100.00 USD, per family member sponsored if the application is through a visa or residency card holder. **Subject to the current exchange rate.**
7. One of the following:
 - A. For spouses: marriage certificate
 - B. For parents: Birth certificate of the Mexican citizen or Resident.
 - C. For minors: Birth certificate of the applicant
 - D. For children of spouses: Birth certificate of the applicant and marriage certificate of the spouse.
8. If you are married to a Mexican national or have Mexican children, proof of their nationality.
