



## RELIGIOUS ACTIVITIES

**Foreigners, ministers of worship or religious associates applying for a visa must present a responsive letter issued by a religious association and a consent letter issued by SEGOB.**

**The visa approval can take up to 10 business days, is valid for six months and includes one entry. Once the applicant arrives in Mexico, it is mandatory to present the Visa at the INM (National Institute of Migration) within the first 30 calendar days of arrival, in order to request a Card.**

### GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

1. Visa application.
2. Valid passport and copy of the main page.
3. One color picture, passport size, front view, with no eyeglasses and white background.
4. Document that proves that the applicant is a foreign legal resident of the USA (I-797, I-20 advance parole, etc.). Not for US citizens.
5. Consular fee: \$51 USD in cash or credit payment (Visa or MasterCard). Non-Refundable if not approved.
6. Original invitation letter of an organization (public or private) indicating that the visa applicant is going to participate in an unpaid activity in National Territory. The letter should contain the following:
  - A. Full name and nationality of the applicant;
  - B. Corporate name of the organization;
  - C. Official registration number of the Company;
  - D. Purpose of the Organization;
  - E. Full address and contact details of the organization or institution
  - F. Information of the activity performed or the project that involved the visa applicant. It must be related with the purposes of the organization or institution inviting the applicant;
  - G. Duration or approximate date of completion of the activity carried out;
  - H. The manifestation of financial shared responsibility while the visa applicant is in Mexico and the return to their country of origin or residence, and
  - I. A copy of the official identification of the person signing the letter of invitation.
7. Original letter of consent (anuencia) from the Ministry of Interior (Secretaría de Gobernación).
