

REQUIREMENTS FOR MEXICAN CITIZENSHIP

Please be informed that the Mexican Government, through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, has implemented a modern platform in its consular network to simplify procedures and provide better service to our community. In particular, the pre-approval review of birth records (dual nationality) and gender identity. To make an appointment we need to verify all documents listed below FIRST, please send scanned copies on PDF format to www.citas.sre.gob.mx

For the person who will be registered:

1. **Original birth certificate.** We will return the original, but make sure it's in perfect condition, and your parent's names match exactly with their birth certificates and their official identifications.
2. **An official identification,** (example: driver's license, official identification, and passport).

For the parents:

❖ *If both parents are
Mexicans:*

3. **Original Mexican birth certificates** of both parents.

❖ *If just one of your
parents is Mexican:*

4. Documentation proving that at least one of your parents is a Mexican citizen (example: **Mexican Birth certificate or Mexican passport**).

5. **Official identification** of the applicant's parents. If mother or father is not Mexican, **will needs to bring her/his foreign passport.**

❖ ***NOTE: If the person applying for Mexican citizenship is older than 18 years and parents are not present the day of the process, it is important consider these additional documents:***

6. **Marriage certificate that proves your parents were married 180 days** (6 months) before you were born. If they do not have that document, your father has to come with you with official identification.

Please, verify that you have all of your documents in order to proceed the day of your appointment.
