

IME BECAS 2025

From April 14th to May 2nd

The **Consulate of México in Detroit**, in accordance with Mexico's Ministry of Foreign Affairs through the Institute for Mexicans Abroad (IMME for its acronym in Spanish), calls on education institutions and social organizations to participate in its IME-Becas program.

The IME-Becas program mission is to offer economic resources for Mexican students currently enrolled in an academic plan offered by social organizations or educational institutions in the United States in one of following modalities:



ADULT EDUCATION

Literacy, elementary school, middle school, GED, HiSET, computing, job training, ESL and job education classes.



HIGHER EDUCATION

Universities, community colleges, university extension programs & specific courses (including online courses)



IME BECAS

20° Aniversario


If you are part of an organization or an educational institution interested in contributing to educational development, come to be part of the twentieth anniversary of IME Becas.


BASES

- Educational institutions and non-profit organizations may present the IME-Becas application at the Consulate of Mexico (Annex 1).
- Only applications committed to contributing with at least the same amount as requested will be considered.
- Incomplete applications or after the deadline submitted will not be accepted. The Postal seal's date will be considered for applications received by mail.

It is the applicant's responsibility to make sure that the Mexican Consulate receives their application form.

REQUIREMENTS

 Submitted the application form signed by the organization representative, attaching the organization bylaws

 Include a proposal (not longer than two pages) enclosing the following elements:






- Mission of the organization.
- Please detail the following:
 - The institution's goals, programs, and achievements in education and support of the Mexican community.
 - Project planning according to the goals focused in the procedures to select the recipients and the evaluation of results.
 - Specify additional resources to help achieve the project's goals.
- Provide the financial plan, including the IME Becas funds requested and additional grants (if applicable). Additionally, indicate the delivery scholarship dates to the recipients.

Deadline for submission of applications:
May 2nd, 2025

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The Consulate will verify that all applications comply with this Call's requirements.

Three prominent and recognized community members will be part of the **Local Committee** and responsible for selecting the institution's recipients. In addition, the Local Committee must be inclusive and will consider the local community education needs, evaluating the following matters:

-  Prioritize those educational institutions capable and committed to matching the IME-Becas funds required.
-  Community institutions/organizations involved in education for adult students may request the Local Committee to consider their operation costs (teachers' salaries, infrastructure) as equivalent of the provided funds.
-  Only those institutions/organizations whose work program complies with the goals and guidelines.
-  The number of Mexican students (including Mexican origin) will be paramount for the selection.
-  The written commitment stating the amount the institution will provide.

SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES



All issues not mentioned in this call must be settled by the Consul of Mexico in accordance with his or her attributions.
