REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TRANSIT OF REMAINS OR ASHES TO MEXICO

- 1.- Original death certificate
- 2.- Certificate of embalming (remains) or certificate of cremation (ashes)
(Notarization for either certificates is required)
- 3.- Transit burial permit (ashes or remains)
- 4.- The three documents have to be translated into Spanish and notarized by a Notary Public

Note: Besides the requirements mentioned above, if the final stop for the remains or ashes is Mexico City, it will be necessary to issue a Mexican Death Certificate.

REQUIREMENTS TO ISSUE A MEXICAN DEATH CERTIFICATE

- 1.- Additional original death certificate
- 2.- Mexican passport or Mexican birth certificate with Mexican ID of the deceased person
- 3.- Informant and two witnesses (they will have to appear in person with official identifications)
- 4.- The cost of each certified copy of the Mexican death certificate is \$13.00.
