

NON PAID ACTIVITIES UP TO 180 DAYS (TOURIST/BUSINESS)

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Visa Application.
- 2. Valid passport and copy of the main page.
- 3. One color picture, passport size, front view, with no eyeglasses and white background.
- 4. Document that proves that the applicant is a foreign legal resident of the USA (I-797, I-20 advance parole, etc). This only applies for non-U.S. citizens.
- 5. Application processing fee \$54.00 Dollars (credit or debit card Visa or Mastercard). *Non refundable if not approved.*
- 6. Proof of economic solvency:
- a) Original and copy of proof of investments or bank accounts with a balance of at least \$4,413.91 US Dollars during the previous 3 months of statements, OR
- b) Original and copy of documents showing that the applicant has a job or pension that yields a monthly income of \$1,471.30 US Dollars after taxes during the previous 3 months, and proof of stable employment of at least one year.
- c) Travelers who are 65 or older, will not be required to show proof of economic solvency as long as they prove that the purpose of travel is tourism activities.

THIS VISA ALLOWS MULTIPLE ENTRIES DURING THE VALIDITY OF THE VISA.

To apply for a visa, you must first submit all required documentation for review via email: visasini@sre.gob.mx.

Once received and reviewed we will contact you to make an appointment via email visasini@sre.gob.mx. or by phone: (317) - 761-7600, Ext. 3116.

Normally, the visa will be issued on the same day of the appointment.
