

## Copa Consulado Soccer Tournament 2017

- This is the Second Edition of Copa Consulado, which concludes the 17<sup>th</sup> Binational Health Week in Kansas City.
- A Bilingual College Fair will take place simultaneously, for encouraging young Hispanics and Mexican-descent people to continue their higher education.

The Binational Health Week (BHW) is a yearly, joint effort organized by the Mexican Consular Network, health organizations and community partners across the United States for promoting positive health habits among the population at large. During October 10-14, 2017 and under the motto "Health unites us all", a wide array of on-site services was offered by the Mexican Consulate in Kansas City and its allies, including vision screenings, HIV tests, glucose-blood pressure check-ups and vaccinations.

For the closing event on Saturday, October 14, the Consulate of Mexico and Soccer Nation are organizing a tournament, *Copa Consulado*, for allowing youngsters to engage in a physical activation event, as a statement of their commitment to creating awareness on the relevance of preventive, low-cost healthy habits in the Kansas City Metropolitan area.

Considering that these are times of uncertainty for many in the Hispanic and Mexicandescent youth, especially for those seeking to continue their higher education, in collaboration with Bank of Labor the Mexican Consulate is also organizing a Bilingual College Fair, simultaneous to *Copa Consulado*. Information on admissions, financial aid, scholarship applications and apprenticeship programs will be provided directly by representatives of Universities and Community Colleges from both Kansas and Missouri to all participants.
