

Temporary Residence Visa with Authorization for Lucrative Activities

General Requirements:

- 1. To schedule an appointment please send an email to: visaslasvegas@sre.gob.mx
- 2. Print and fill out the visa application form: https://consulmex.sre.gob.mx/lasvegas/index.php/servicios-extranjeros/visas
- 3. One passport-size photograph: white background, clear view of the face (glasses or other accessories are NOT ALLOWED, filters or image alterations are NOT ALLOWED.)
- 4. Comply with original or certified documents required according to the category.
- 5. Visa fee: \$51 USD

The appointment does NOT guarantee the issuance of the visa; it is the applicant's responsibility to provide the required documents on the day of their interview. Applicants must present original documents and if required, the proper certifications and/or apostilles. The processing time of a visa may take

1-10 business days from the day of the appointment.

The process for temporary residence with authorization for lucrative activities must be requested by the employer at the National Immigration Institute (INM). Once the institute has approved the employer's application, they will issue a (NUT) number and the visa applicant must process the visa application at a Mexican Consulate within 30 days.

Documents required during an interview at Mexican Consulate

- The person who wishes to obtain a visa with permission to carry out remunerated activities in Mexico, must attend a consular interview and present the following documents:
- Original of a letter of offer of employment that includes the following characteristics:
- Letterhead
- That indicates the occupation that the foreigner will develop according to the classification
 of the National System of Classification of Occupations or the one that in its moment
 replaces this one,
- Temporality required for employment
- Place of employment
- Amount of remuneration;
- Copy of identification of the employer's legal representative.
- Copy of the employer's proof of registration with the Institute.
- Document of (NUT) Unique Processing Number issued by the authorities of the National Migration Institute.

It is important to point out that the consular interview must be carried out within 30 days after the NUT is assigned.
