| Applicable in the following cases: | Applicable to foreigners who intend to enter Mexico as a visitor for adoption purposes and who are nationals or habitual residents of a country that is a member of the Convention on the Protection of Minors and Cooperation in Matters of International Adoption or of a country which Mexico has signed an agreement on the matter. |

| Place where it is presented: | Consulate of Mexico. |
| Schedule Interview: | <p>In order to process visa applications, it is necessary to previously schedule an individual appointment.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Appointments must be scheduled through the following portal: https://citas.sre.gob.mx/</p> <p><u>The appointment does NOT guarantee the issuance of the visa; it is the applicant's responsibility to provide the required documents the day of their interview. Applicant must present original documents and a copy. The processing time of a visa may take 1-10 business days from the day of the appointment.</u></p> |
| Documents required on the day of the interview: | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Print and fill out the visa application form (Available on the official website of the Consulate) https://consulmex.sre.gob.mx/lasvegas/index.php/mnnpdi/mnvisasnp 2. Passport that is valid under international law and in force, must provide an original and copy 3. Original and copy of the adoptive or pre-assignment report issued by the National System for the Integral Development of the Family (DIF), which indicates information on the identity of the child or adolescent. 4. Original and copy of acceptance of the assignment of the child and the continuation of the adoption procedure issued by the Central Authority of the Receiving State in which its will and that of the applicants to continue with the adoption process is expressed. 5. Payment of fees for the issuance of a visa in accordance with the provisions of the Federal Law on fees: \$56 USD |
