

Temporary Residence Visa with Authorization for Lucrative Activities

General Requirements:

1. Appointments must be scheduled through the following portal: <https://citas.sre.gob.mx/>
2. Print and fill out the visa application form:
<https://consulmex.sre.gob.mx/lasvegas/index.php/mnnpdi/mnvisasnp>
3. Comply with original or certified documents required according to the category.
4. Visa fee: **\$56 USD/\$321 USD**

The appointment does NOT guarantee the issuance of the visa; it is the applicant's responsibility to provide the required documents on the day of their interview. Applicants must present original documents and if required, the proper certifications and/or apostilles. The processing time of a visa may take 1-10 business days from the day of the appointment.

The process for temporary residence with authorization for lucrative activities must be requested by the employer at the National Immigration Institute (INM). Once the institute has approved the employer's application, they will issue a (NUT) number and the visa applicant must process the visa application at a Mexican Consulate within 30 days.

Documents required during an interview at Mexican Consulate

- Document of **NUT (Unique Processing Number)** issued by the authorities of the National Migration Institute.
- Original and a legible copy of a **valid passport or identity document**
- Original and a copy of the **document proving legal status**, if the foreign national is not a citizen of the country where the visa is being requested.

It is important to point out that the consular interview must be carried out within 30 days after the NUT is assigned.
