Both parties need to be present during the interview.</li> <li>Marriage with a temporary resident visa/card holder:</li> <li>Marriage or common-law certificate, and one copy.</li> <li>ID of visa or resident card holder.</li> </ul>
Invitation from an organization or a public or private institution.	<ul> <li>Invitation letter.</li> <li>Last 12 bank statements of the organization sponsoring your trip with an average balance of 140,000 USD.</li> </ul>

For applicants performing religious activities in Mexico, please
present a letter of consent issued by the Ministry of the Interior
(anuencia favorable).
