

Temporary resident visa for students.

This type of visa is for you if:

- You are traveling to study in Mexico.
- You receive a scholarship from the Mexican Government.
- You do not have a work authorization.

General requirements:

- Application form ([English](#) or [Español](#))
- Valid passport in original and photocopy.
- Valid US VISA/ESTA and one photocopy.
- I-20; Original I-94, J-1 or I-797A and a one copy. (Or any other form that proves your legal status in the United States of America).
- One photo: passport size, white background, in color and without glasses.
- Consular fee \$53.00 USD in cash.

In addition, you need to present the following documents, depending on your situation:

The letter must include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Student´s full name. - Degree if applicable. - Course name. - Period. - Cost of tuition. - Contact information. <input type="checkbox"/> Proof of economic solvency: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Last 3 months of paystubs with minimum income of \$1,400.00USD. Or - Last 3 bank statements with minimum balance of \$14,300.00USD. Or - Proof of financial support or scholarship. Or - For applicants under 25; letter from parents clearly stating that they will cover the applicant's expenses. The letter must be accompanied by the last 3 bank statements from their accounts.
Under an international instrument for academic mobility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Official application indicating the instrument under which they are applying for a visa.

IMPORTANT:

- If you are traveling to New York City to apply for a visa, please beware that applications are processed in a period of 10 business days. Please consider this when making travel arrangements.
- Applicants **under 18 years old** must be accompanied by both parents.
- The consular fee is non-refundable and does not guarantee that the visa will be approved.
