

Visa de Residente Temporal Estudiante

This type of visa is for you if:

You are traveling to study in Mexico.

You receive a scholarship from the Mexican Government.

You do not have a work authorization.

General requirements:

- ☐ Application form ([English](#) or [Español](#))
- ☐ Valid Passport and one copy.
- ☐ Valid US visa/ESTA and one copy.
- ☐ Extension I-20; I-94, J-1 ó I-797A and one copy.
- ☐ One photo passport size: white background, in color, no glasses.
- ☐ Consular fee \$54.00 USD, in cash. (exact change)

In addition, you need to present the following documents, depending on your situation:

OR– Last 3 bank statements with minimum balance of \$14,300.00USD. OR– Proof of financial support or scholarship. OR– For applicants under 25; letter from parents clearly stating that they will cover the applicant's expenses. The letter must be accompanied by the last 3 bank statements from their accounts.
Under an international legal instrument for student mobility.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Written statement in which the applicant submits their candidacy to the Consular Office, indicating the instrument under which they are applying for a visa.<input type="checkbox"/> Meet each of the requirements set forth in the corresponding international legal instrument for student mobility, established by the immigration authorities, based on current regulations.

IMPORTANT:

- If you are traveling to New York City to apply for a visa, please beware that applications are processed in a period of 10 business days. Please consider this when making travel arrangements.
- Applicants under 18 years old must be accompanied by both parents.
- The consular fee is non-refundable and does not guarantee that the visa will be approved.
