Family unification	 Marriage with a Mexican citizen: Marriage or common-law certificate, and one photocopy. Mexican passport or birth certificate of both parties, in original and one photocopy. Both parties need to be present during the interview. Marriage with a temporary resident visa/card holder:
	Marriage or common-law certificate, and one photocopy.ID of visa or resident card holder.
