

Permanent Residents

This type of visa is for you if:

You are retired and have the Social Security Statement.

You are moving to Mexico definitely.

You do not have work authorization.

General requirements:

- ☐ Application form ([English](#) or [Español](#))
- ☐ Valid Passport and one copy.
- ☐ Valid US visa/ESTA and one copy.
- ☐ Extension I-20; I-94, J-1 ó I-797A and one copy.
- ☐ One photo passport size: white background, in color, no glasses.
- ☐ Consular fee \$54.00 USD, in cash. (exact change)

In addition, you need to present the following documents, depending on your situation:

Retired	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Last 12 months of bank statements or personal investments with an average balance of 280,000 USD. OR<input type="checkbox"/> Last 6 months of paystubs or social security pension with a minimum amount of 7,100 USD.
Family unification	<p>Marriage with a Mexican citizen:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Marriage or common-law certificate, and one photocopy.<input type="checkbox"/> Mexican passport or birth certificate of both parties, in original and one photocopy. Both parties need to be present during the interview. <p>Marriage with a temporary resident visa/card holder:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Marriage or common-law certificate, and one photocopy.<input type="checkbox"/> ID of visa or resident card holder.

IMPORTANT:

- If you are traveling to New York City to apply for a visa, please beware that applications are processed in a period of 10 business days. Please consider this when making travel arrangements.
- The consular fee is non-refundable and does not guarantee that the visa will be approved.
