

Visitor Visa for Adoption Procedures

Applicable to foreign nationals who wish to enter Mexico under the immigration status of Visitor for adoption purposes and who are nationals or habitual residents of a country that is a member of the Hague Convention on Protection of Children and Cooperation in Respect of Intercountry Adoption, or of a country with which Mexico has signed an agreement on the matter.

Requirements:

- I. Valid Passport or id travel document under international law, in original,
- II. Original Adoption Eligibility or Pre-Assignment Report issued by the National System for Comprehensive Family Development (DIF), containing information on the identity of the child or teenager,
- III. Original acceptance of the child assignment and continuation of the adoption procedure issued by the Central Authority of the Receiving State, expressing its will and that of the applicants to proceed with the adoption, and
- IV. Payment of fees for the reception, review of the application, and, if applicable, authorization of the visa, in accordance with the provisions of the Federal Fees Law.

NOTE: Within 30 calendar days from the date of entry into national territory, the foreign national must obtain, from the National Immigration Institute, the visitor card for adoption purposes.

Fee:

For the reception, processing, and, if applicable, authorization of the visa: \$54.00 USD

Appointment Request:

Once you have gathered the necessary requirements to apply for your visa, you must schedule an appointment by sending an email with your full name as it appears in your passport to: conomaha@sre.gob.mx

Appointments are personal and non-transferable.

Important Information: Holding a visa does not guarantee entry into national territory. It only allows the foreign national to present themselves at a port of entry to request entry into the country. Entry into Mexico is subject to approval by health and immigration authorities at ports of entry, known as immigration checkpoints, who may at any time conduct an interview regarding the purpose of the trip and verify the requirements established in the applicable legal provisions (Article 37 of the Immigration Law and Article 60 of its Regulations).
