

### **Visitor visa without permission to engage in paid activities (Tourist)**

Applicable to foreigners who wish to enter Mexico under the immigration status of visitor without permission to engage in remunerated activities, for a period of up to 180 days.

#### *Requirements:*

- I. Valid Passport or id travel document under international law, in original,
- II. Original document proving legal stay, if the foreigner is not a citizen of the country where the visa is being requested, and
- III. Submit documents proving any of the following:
  - a) Proof of ties to the country of residence
    1. Original of registered public deed of real estate property under the applicant's name for at least two years, and proof of permanent employment for a minimum of two years; or
    2. Original registered public deed of real estate property under the applicant's name for at least two years, and a document proving ownership or participation in a business issued by the competent authorities of the country, with a minimum of two years.
  - b) Economic solvency
    1. Original documents showing employment or pension with monthly, tax-free greater than \$1,310 USD for the last three months, and proof of permanent employment for at least one year; or
    2. Original or digitally certified document of proof of investments or bank accounts with an average monthly balance equivalent to \$4,050 USD for the last three months; or
    3. For foreign nationals who are enrolled as regular students in higher education institutions, an original or digitally certified document proving enrollment, and an original proof of permanent employment, pension, or scholarship with monthly income equivalent to \$804 USD for the last three months.
  - c) Invitation from a public or private organization or institution.
  - d) Truck driver or cargo transport operator whose sole purpose of entry into national territory is to load or unload goods.
  - e) Humanitarian reasons.
  - f) Scientific research or collection of samples within national territory or national jurisdictional waters, upon prior authorization from the competent national authorities in waters of territorial jurisdiction.
  - g) Studies.
  - h) Participation in an event sponsored or organized by the Federal Government, as well as by autonomous constitutional bodies, for a maximum duration of 180 days.

*Fee:*

For the reception, processing, and, if applicable, authorization of the visa: \$54.00 USD

*Appointment Request:*

Once you have gathered the necessary requirements to apply for your visa, you must schedule an appointment by sending an email with your full name as it appears in your passport to: [conomaha@sre.gob.mx](mailto:conomaha@sre.gob.mx)

**Appointments are personal and non-transferable.**

There are no family appointments. Each adult must make their request individually. Minors under 18 years old may have their appointment scheduled by their parents or legal guardians.

*Important Information: Holding a visa does not guarantee entry into national territory. It only allows the foreign national to present themselves at a port of entry to request entry into the country. Entry into Mexico is subject to approval by health and immigration authorities at ports of entry, known as immigration checkpoints, who may at any time conduct an interview regarding the purpose of the trip and verify the requirements established in the applicable legal provisions (Article 37 of the Immigration Law and Article 60 of its Regulations).*
