

Temporary Residence Visa: Economic Solvency

Making an Appointment

- Please make your appointment for a **visa** at citas.sre.gob.mx or by calling 1-424-309-0009, appointments for other consular services will not be accepted. Appointments open monthly, if no appointments are available, please try again at the end of the month. You should select the option VISAS, if you select other service your visa application will not be accepted.
- Individual appointments must be made for all applicants.
- Appointments cannot be made in person at the consulate.
- Print and fill out the visa application form

The Consular Interview

- We are located at 2550 Technology Drive, Orlando, FL 32804.
- Please arrive 15 minutes before your scheduled appointment time.
- The payment of 51 dollars is **cash** only and is nonrefundable, even if your visa is denied.
- All applicants must present themselves in person for the consular interview, including children.
- Be advised that the consular interview may take a few hours and processing of the visa may take
ten business days.

Required Documents to Present at the Consular Interview

1. Valid passport or travel document; original and photocopy.
2. One passport size photograph with face visible and forward facing on a white background; no hats or glasses.
3. If not American you must prove your legal status in the United States with originals and copies of documents.
4. Economic Solvency
 - a. Original and copy of documents that demonstrate personal investments or bank accounts with a minimum monthly balance of 43,218 USD during the last 12 months. 12 separate statements are required. Business or corporate accounts will not be accepted. **OR,**
 - b. Original and copy of documents that demonstrate pension with a minimum monthly income of 2,594 USD. This requires both deposit statements from a bank account and a verification letter from the entity offering the pension stating the duration of the pension and monthly amount. Monthly statements for the past 6 months are required. Business or corporate accounts will not be accepted. **OR,**
 - c. Original and copy of documents that demonstrate employment with a minimum monthly income of 2,589 USD. This requires deposit statements from a bank account, pay stubs, and a letter from your employer stating a brief work description, start date, duration of your employment, monthly salary, ability to work remotely, and that your payment will be deposited in a bank account in the US. Monthly statements for the past 6 months are required. Business or corporate accounts will not be accepted.

Important Information

- Documents can only be reviewed at the consular appointment and not through email.
- Visa approval is subject to evaluation based on the interview and presented documents.
