

## Student Temporary Resident Visa

Foreigners, who wish to remain in Mexico for a period greater than 180 days to attend courses, pursue studies, or conduct research projects at an educational institution belonging to the National Educational System in Mexico must present the corresponding requirements:

	School	Letter of acceptance from the institution where the applicant intends to study. This letter must include: Student's name, degree and area of study that will be pursued, name of the course, start and end dates of the course, cost of school fees, school's contact information.	Mandatory

Family Unity Applications may only be accepted at a Consular Office if the foreigner with temporal or permanent resident status in Mexico or Mexican citizen accompanies the family member at the time the application is submitted.

In compliance with all requirements a valid single-entry visa will be issued. Once the applicant has entered Mexican territory, he or she must, within the first 30 calendar days, apply to **the National Migration Institute (INM)** for a temporary resident card.
