

PENSIONERS (CERTIFICATE OF SURVIVAL)

Appointment required

Requirements

1. **Attendance of the person requesting the Certificate to prove the Physical Survival of Pensioners.**
2. **Application** This form must be completed in its entirety. Please specify the institution that grants the pension, as well as your pensioner number.
3. **Valid official identification of the applicant, original and one letter-size copy (both sides)** You may present a Mexican passport, or a Consular Registration Card, or a Voter ID from the National Electoral Institute (formerly the Federal Electoral Institute), or a National Military Service Card, or a foreign passport (booklet type), or a driver's license or identification issued by the California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV).
4. **Pensioner's Credential** (containing name, photograph and signature), or if applicable, present the last pension payment receipt (slip), original and a letter-size copy (both sides).
5. Copy of the latest Certificate of Survival.
6. **A passport-sized color photograph** With a white background, facing forward, and without glasses. The photograph must be recent (no more than 30 days old). *Except for IMSS

The Certificate of Survival will be delivered If possible, the document should be delivered on the same day or the next business day after the procedure is completed. The pensioner's presence is required to sign the document upon receipt.

Procedure

You will need to request an appointment. **Sending an email** to clv@consulmexsd.org indicating the pensioner's full name, telephone number, the institution that grants the pension, the pensioner's number, and that they already have all the requirements, in order to schedule an appointment.

On the day of your appointment, you must appear at this Consulate with all the required documents.

- **IMSS Pensioners**

Starting in January 2017, the process for obtaining a proof of life certificate for IMSS pensioners who receive their pension directly from the Institute will be carried out exclusively electronically. To do so, they must submit the established requirements, except for the photograph*.

Once the process is complete, you will receive an electronic confirmation. For any questions regarding your proof of life, you should contact the IMSS and/or your bank.

In the case of IMSS pensioners who receive their pension directly from a banking institution, the certificate of survival will be carried out with the same requirements, including the photograph.

- **ISSFAM pensioners**

By official order, the process will be carried out online. To do so, you only need to present your pensioner's ID card, and once the process is complete, you will receive a confirmation number.

In exceptional situations, you may be asked to provide additional documentation to complete your application.
