

Subsequent Testimony

Appointment Required

This refers to the issuance of the same notarial instrument obtained from its original, with a recent issuance date; that is, it will be issued without any modification to the notarial act. Copies of a notarial act may be requested, provided that it was executed before this Consulate General of Mexico in San Diego, California, and the Protocol Book containing it has not yet been sent to the General Archive of Notaries of Mexico City, in accordance with current legislation.

Requirements:

- 1. Attendance of the person requesting the Subsequent Testimony at their appointment.**
- 2. Application.** It must be filled completely.
- 3. Present a valid official identification and two letter-size photocopies (front and back on the same side of the sheet).** Only the following are accepted as identification: Passport (Mexican or foreign), Consular Registration Card, Voter ID issued by the Federal/National Electoral Institute, Driver's License or identification issued by the California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV).
Note: In the identification you present, the name must be the same as it appears in the primary notarial act.
- 4. Submit a legible copy of the Notarial Act testimony.** The copy of the Notarial Act must be complete, that is, of the entire document; it cannot be partial.
- 5. Payment of \$12.00 per sheet.** For fees, payment is accepted in cash and/or by card (except American Express).

Procedure:

1. You will have to **schedule an appointment** through the "MiConsulado" system by phone or WhatsApp at 1-424-309-0009 or online through <https://citas.sre.gob.mx>. Make sure to schedule an appointment with the Fe Publica Department. If your preferred consular office, in this case San Diego, is not listed, it's because there is currently no availability. Appointments open on Mondays and are scheduled quickly, so it's recommended to check back.
 2. On the day of your appointment, you must appear unaccompanied at this Consulate with your application and supporting documents for review. After the review, if everything is complete and correct, you will make the corresponding payment. The subsequent certificate will be delivered within 3 to 5 business days, starting from the date of receipt.
- In exceptional situations, you may be asked to provide additional documentation to complete your application.
