IMME BECAS 2026

March 29th to May 4th

The **Consulate of Mexico in San Jose, California**, with the support of the Secretariat of Foreign Affairs through the Institute of Mexicans Abroad (IMME), invites educational institutions and social organizations interested in participating in IMME-Becas 2026 to obtain financial grants **for Mexican nationals or individuals of Mexican origin enrolled in one of their academic programs**, at the following educational levels:

EDUCATION FOR EMPLOYMENT

Programs and/or technical skills training workshops in trades that improve employability. HiSET exam preparation programs and General Educational Development (GED) exam training.

HIGHER EDUCATION

Universities, community colleges, university extension programs, technical education, specific courses (including online courses)

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Interested educational institutions and social organizations must submit the application for financial support from IMME-Becas 2026 at the Consulate of Mexico.
- Only applications from institutions or organizations that contribute to multiplying additional funds **that at least match the amount requested will be considered.**
- Incomplete applications or those submitted after the closing date will not be accepted; for mail submissions, the postmark date will be considered, not the date of receipt at the consular offices.

It will be the responsibility of the organizations or institutions to ensure that the consular representation received their application.

REQUIREMENTS

- Submit the funding application signed by the representative of the institution or organization, along with its annexes:
 - Copy of the legal statutes (*bylaws*) of the institution/organization.
- Include a proposal with the following elements, with a maximum length of three pages:
 - Mission of the educational institution or nonprofit social organization.
 - Description of:
 - The organization or institution, its objectives, programs, activities, and achievements in the field of education and educational development of Mexican migrants.
 - Its projects and plans to meet the expected goals (anticipating the results that would be achieved with IMME-Becas funds and complementary resources), as well as the procedures to evaluate the achievement of objectives.
 - Other contributions received and anticipated by the institution / organization to help meet the project objectives and related activities.
 - Budget detailing the proposed expenditures by the applicant institution or organization, including a brief explanation of the purpose of said expenditures. Additionally, it must indicate how financial support will be distributed among students, and when the corresponding support will be delivered, depending on the option.

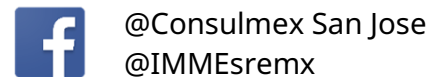
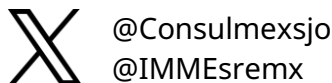
SELECTION PROCESS

The Consulate will verify that applications meet the requirements of the Call. The selection of institutions and organizations will be carried out by a **Local Committee** composed of at least three prominent individuals from the consular district, connected to education and community work. The Local Committee must be inclusive and address local educational needs.

- Preference will be given to institutions and organizations that can match the funds requested from IMME-Becas; that is, those that, through other funding sources, supplement the funds in an amount equal to or greater than what is presented in their application.
- In the case of community organizations that provide employment education, at their express request, the Local Committee may take into account the operating costs (teacher compensation, infrastructure) as equivalent to contributed funds.
- Only institutions and organizations whose work plan meets the objectives and guidelines of this Call will be considered.
- The number of Mexican nationals or individuals of Mexican origin who will benefit will be taken into account, in accordance with the selected modality.
- To determine the amount of support, the written commitment stated in the application regarding the amount that institutions and organizations will contribute to their financial support program will be taken into account.

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Any matter not provided for in this call shall be resolved by the Head of the Consulate, in accordance with their authority.



PUBLICATION OF RESULTS

The Consulate will publish the results of the Call on May 6th, 2026.
