

## Visitor visa without permission to conduct remunerated activities

Foreigners who require a visa and wish to enter Mexico with the intention of performing activities such as tourism, business, technical assistance, transportation, studies, or as journalists, for a period of less than 180 days and if the foreigner is not going to work in Mexico, must present the corresponding requirements for a ten years or six months visa:

Letter must include:Applicant's name & nationality, inst. name, registration number, purpose of organization, address and contact info of the organization, activity and length and the commitment to provide support for the foreigner during his/her stay in Mexico and to ensure that the foreigner returns to his/her country of origin or residence	Submit the three

			In the event that the inviting institution will not cover living expenses: bank statements showing an average monthly balance of over \$2,590 USD (6 months) or a salary or pension of over \$777 USD (6 months).

			Original letter from a bus/truck drivers public or private organization that must include: applicants name, registration number, address and contact information. Copy of the official identification of the person signing the letter.

		International self volenteer(i.e. international medical education or any type of emergency): Proof of Government invitation		
<b>Scientific research in waters under Mexican jurisdiction</b>	Communication through which the Embassy of the applicant's country of nationality or residence in Mexico notifies the foreigner that the Mexican Ministry of Foreign Affairs (SRE) received authorization from the competent national authorities. Letter must include: Applicant's name & nationality, inst. name, activity and length.			
<b>Students</b>	Letter of acceptance from an institution belonging to the National Educational System to take courses, pursue studies or conduct research projects or undertake academic or professional training for a period of less than 180 days, specifying: applicant's name, level, degree and area of studies, start and end date of the course and school's contact information.			
	Economic solvency to cover the amount of school fees and room: investments receipts or bank statements showing an average monthly balance equivalent to \$1,554 USD or employment or pension with an income greater than \$777 USD (6 meses).			
	Solvency may be proven by the applicant or by his/her parents or guardians as long as the applicant is not over the age of 25, or by a letter from the educational institution stating that the applicant has been awarded a scholarship.			

## Notes:

- 1) **Immigration authorities may decide to refuse the request to enter the country if the applicant is subject to criminal process or has been convicted of a serious crime.**
- 2) **Visitors on cruise ships:** Visitors who travel on cruise ships that disembark at any Mexican port to visit the surrounding zones and embark on the same ship to continue their voyage, do not require a visa and will have collective permission under the category of “visitor without permission to conduct remunerated activities”, for a period of 21 calendar days.
