LOCAL MATCHING FUNDS CALL MODEL

The **Consulate of Mexico in Tucson**, with the support of the Secretariat of Foreign Affairs, through the Institute for Mexicans Abroad, calls on education institutions and social organizations to participate in IMME Scholarships 2026 to get financial support **for Mexican nationals or individuals of Mexican origin enrolled** in one of their academic programs, at the following educational levels:

EDUCATION FOR EMPLOYMENT

Programs and/or technical training workshops in trades that enhance employability, including HiSET exam preparation programs and General Educational Development (GED) exam training.

HIGHER EDUCATION

Universities, community colleges, university extension programs, technical education, and specialized courses (including online courses).

If you are an organization or institution interested in contributing to educational development, please contact the Consulate.



GUIDELINES

- Educational institutions and social organizations interested must submit their application for IMME Scholarships 2026 financial support at the Consulate of Mexico. In annex 1 the total amount for 2026 is stated as well as the information where the application form may be presented.
- Only those applications officially supported by the Consulate of Mexico, and which are committed to contribute with **at least the same amount as the one requested**.
- Incomplete application forms will not be accepted nor those presented after this call's deadline. For those applications received by mail, the Postal seal's date will be taken into consideration.

It will be the responsibility of the organizations or institutions to ensure that the consular representation has received their application.

REQUIREMENTS

Hand in corresponding application form signed by the organization/institution's representative and its annexes:

- The institution/organization's **bylaws**.

Include a proposal (not longer than two pages) enclosing the following elements:

- Mission of the applicant (non profit institution/organization).
- Description of:
 - The applicant organization/institution's: goals, activities, programs and achievements in the fields of education and personal development of the Mexican migrant community.
 - Its plans and projects to achieve its expected goals (anticipating the results to be reached with the IME-Becas funds plus the additional resources) as well as the tools and procedures to evaluate the achievement of its goals.
 - Other money contributions anticipated or already received by the organization/institution to help achieve the project's goals and its activities.
- Detailed budget describing the organization/institution's expected expenses including a brief explanation of the expenses' purpose. Also, clearly explain how this financial support will be distributed among students and when they will be handed over to these recipients depending on which option, they are considered in.



SELECTION PROCEDURE

The Consulate will verify that all applications comply with this Call's requirements. The selection of institutions and organizations will be carried out by a **Local Committee** composed of three prominent members of each consular jurisdiction, with ties to education and community work. The Local Committee must be inclusive and address local educational needs.

- Those institutions/organizations which are capable to match the IMME Scholarships funds they applied for, will be prioritized.
- Community institutions/organizations involved in education for adult students may request the Local Committee to consider their operation costs (teachers' salaries, infrastructure) as equivalent of the provided funds.
- Only those institutions/organizations whose work program complies with the goals and guidelines of this Call will be taken into consideration.
- The number of Mexican students (including those of Mexican origin) will be paramount when selecting the institution/organization which will receive the funds in accordance with each modality.
- To establish the sum to be granted, the written commitment enclosed in the application stating the amount the organization/institution will provide, is paramount to determine the sum to be granted by IMME Scholarships.

DISPUTE RESOLUTION



Any matter not provided for in this Call for Applications shall be resolved by the Head of the Consulate, in accordance with their powers and responsibilities.
