VISA WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE “INSTITUTO NACIONAL DE MIGRACION (INM)”

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Visa Application.
2. Valid passport and copy of the main page.
3. One color picture, passport size, front view, with no eyeglasses and white background.
4. Document that proves that the applicant is a foreign legal resident of the USA (I-797, I-20 advance parole, etc). *This only applies for non-U.S. citizens.*
5. Application processing fee \$36.00 dollars (credit or debit card – visa or mastercard). Non refundable if not approved.
6. Immigration fee \$210.00 dollars (cash, credit or debit card – visa or mastercard). Applies only for the visa “Visitante con permiso para realizar actividades remuneradas”.
7. Copy of the approval letter issued by the “Instituto Nacional de Migracion (INM)” where the “Número Único de Trámite (NUT)” is indicated.

AFTER ENTERING MEXICO WITH THIS KIND OF VISA, YOU SHOULD GO TO THE NEAREST “INSTITUTO NACIONAL DE MIGRACIÓN” (INM) OFFICE TO GET YOUR RESIDENT ID.

To apply for a visa, you must first make an appointment per person, please visit: <https://seccionconsularwashington.youcanbook.me/>

Normally, the visa will be ready on the same day of the appointment at 1:30 p.m.

- In case you are asked to support your application with complimentary documentation, you will be given a new appointment date.
- If you present a document issued from a country different than Mexico or the United States of America, it must come with an apostille or legalization as applicable; and with an official translation to Spanish.
